warm front	forms when a warm air mass pushes up and over a cold air mass
stationary front	forms when a cold air mass meets a warm air mass and neither one can
	move the other
tropical climate	characterized by year-long warm temperatures; occurs near the equator
temperate climate	characterized by seasonal changes in temperature; has distinct seasons
albedo	measure of the amount of sunlight reflected by a surface; snow, ice, and
	sand have high albedo
altitude	height above sea level
latitude	distance north or south of the equator
steppe	climate with vegetation consisting mostly of small grasses and shrubs
monsoonal	characterized by a season of strong winds and intense rains
humid	characterized by having a high amount of water in the air
