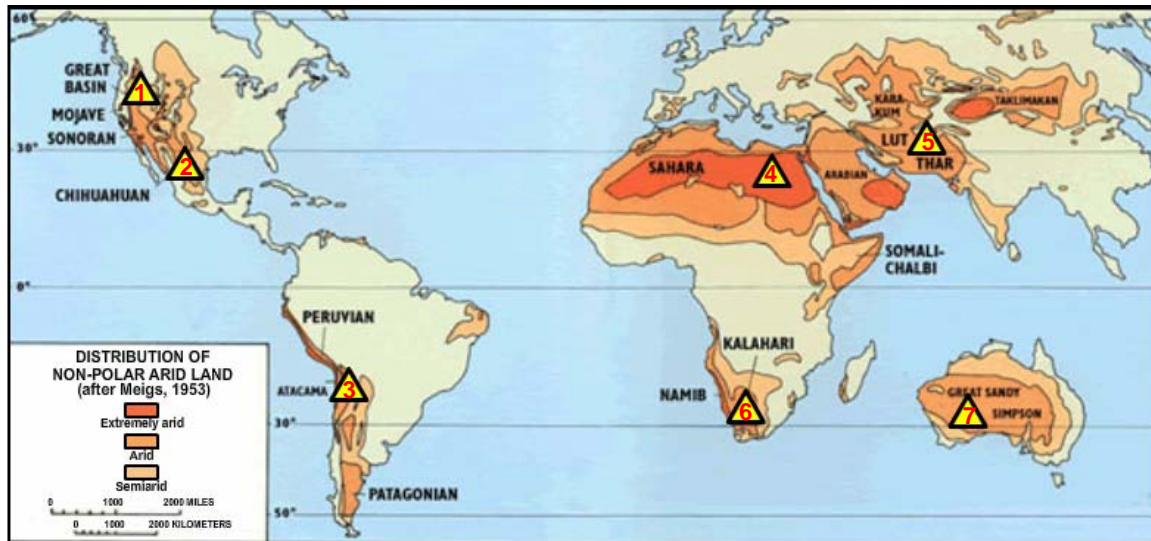







Interactive: Desert Eolian Environments
