Michael Green states, "We are taking it to our awards and nominations sub-committee on the first of December. They may choose to give the Grammy to the second runner-up. They may choose to no one this year. They just may say 'Best New Artist – no Grammy given'."

At the press conference

Rob Pilatus says, "Brett Howell and Shawn Davis are the real singers, and I think they should get this Grammy. We told Frank Barron that if we can't sing on our record, you have to go to the press and say we can't sing. We couldn't get Frank out of our contract. Just the producer can stop the contract. The artist couldn't stop the contract and try to release other albums for other producers without the record companies. We had to pressurize him and step back. We finished this thing."

Reporter, "Who owns Milli Vanilli?"

Pilatus, "Frank Barron."
