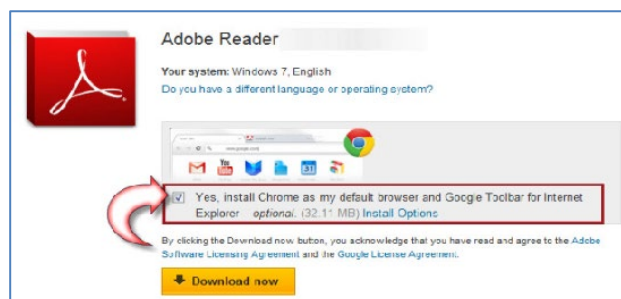


## Read a PDF File

PDF files are in a “Portable Document Format.” PDF files may be read on most types of operating systems. In order to open a .PDF document, click on the file link and see if your computer can open it.

Most of the PDFs we have in the DoDEA Virtual High School are published for Adobe Reader version 9 or higher, and our school computers should have Adobe Reader installed.

If you need a copy of this free program at home, **Adobe Acrobat Reader** is available for download from <http://get.adobe.com/reader>. This download includes the installation of the **Google Chrome** internet browser. **Deselect this option if you do not need this browser installed.**



## Create a PDF File

It is easy to save a document, spreadsheet, or presentation in the “Portable Document Format” if you have the right software. Once your file is ready to be published to a PDF file:

- Click the Print button.
- Change the printer to Adobe PDF.
- Verify where you want the PDF file saved and the name you want to give it.
- View the new file.
