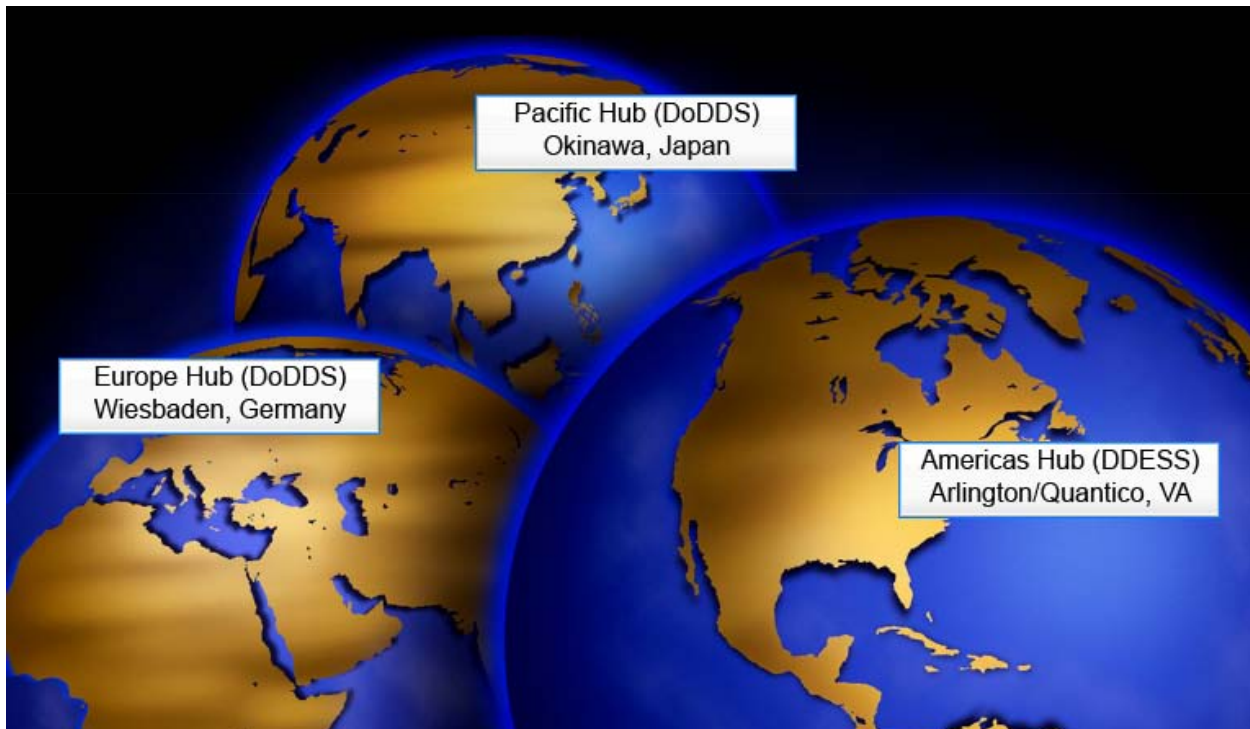


Overview of the DoDEA Virtual High School
