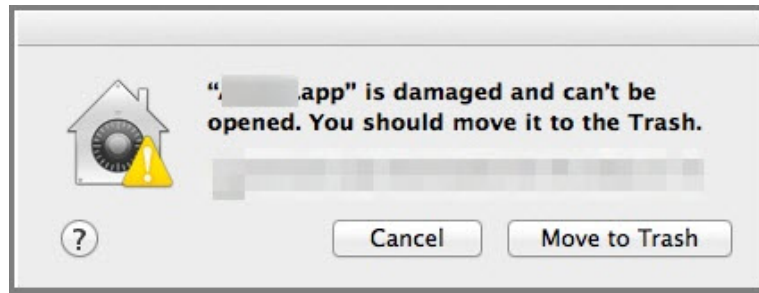
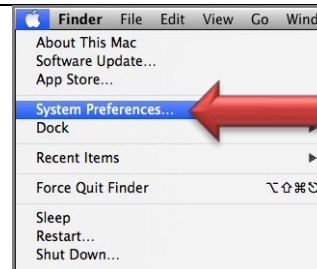


MAC computer sometimes require additional steps to install the SPARK app.

1. Since this app was not acquired from the **Apps Store**, you may receive a message similar to the this one. You will need to adjust your security preferences.



2. Select the **Apple** icon and then select **System Preferences**.



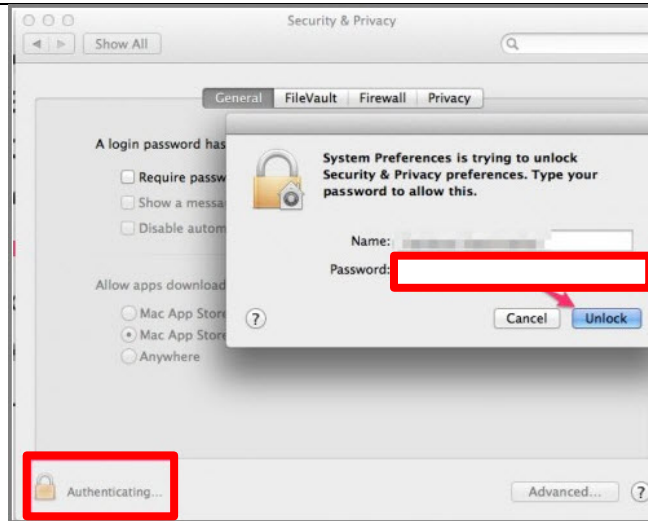
3. On the **System Preferences** panel, choose **Security & Privacy** option.



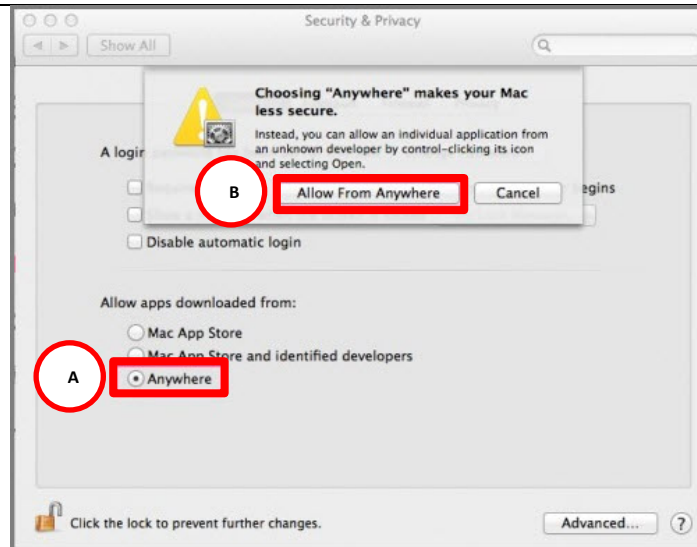
4. On the **Security & Privacy** panel, choose the **General** tab. You will need to change the **Allow apps downloaded from:** option, select the **Lock** icon to start the change process.



5. In the dialog box that appears enter your Administrator password and then click the **Unlock** button.
- If you have not set a password, leave it blank by pressing the **Enter** button on your keyboard.



6. Back on the **General** tab. Change the **Allow apps downloaded from:** option to **Anywhere**.
- In the dialog box that opens choose **Allow From Anywhere**. Close these panels to lock the **Security & Privacy** options again.



7. Now open the spark.app file you need to install. The error message now warns you it was downloaded from the Internet and asks you to verify you would like to open it. Click the **Open** button to begin the install.
